

What Almost Dying Teaches Us About Living. At 22, Suleika Jaouad's dream of becoming a war correspondent while living in Paris, after falling in love, came to an abrupt halt. Instead, she was faced with a devastating diagnosis: leukemia, with a 35 percent chance of survival. During this webcast, you'll hear how Suleika chronicled her fight to survive amidst countless rounds of chemo, a clinical trial, and a bone marrow transplant in an Emmy Award-winning New York Times column of "Life, Interrupted." Suleika will relay how when she finally walked out of the cancer ward, she soon learned that a cure is not where the work of healing ends; it's where it begins. With probing questions posed by author and work and life expert, Debbie Epstein Henry, Suleika will share highlights of her debut memoir, Between Two Kingdoms, a profound recounting of survivorship and a fierce, tender, and inspiring exploration of what it means to begin again. Suleika will also put her experiences in today's context and talk about The Isolation Journals, a community creativity project with over 100,000 participants that she founded during the Covid-19 pandemic to help others convert isolation into artistic solitude.

Suleika Jaouad is the author of the New York Times best-selling debut memoir, Between Two Kingdoms. She wrote the Emmy Award-winning New York Times column "Life, Interrupted" and her work has appeared in the New York Times Magazine, The Atlantic, Vogue, and NPR, among others. She began writing her New York Times column from her hospital room at Sloan-Kettering after her career aspirations as a war correspondent were cut short when, at age 22, she was diagnosed with leukemia. She has since become a fierce advocate for those living with illness and enduring life's many other interruptions. A highly sought-after speaker, her mainstage TED Talk was one of the ten most popular of 2019 and has nearly four million views. She is also the creator of The Isolation Journals, a community creativity project founded during the Covid-19 pandemic to help others convert isolation into artistic solitude; over 100,000 people from around the world have joined.

Debbie Epstein Henry is an expert, consultant, author, and public speaker on careers, workplaces, women and law. She runs DEH Consulting, Speaking Writing where she speaks internationally, including The Hague, the French Senate, London, and Vienna. Debbie wrote two ABA best-selling books and she's been featured by hundreds of news outlets including *The New York Times*, NBC Nightly News, and *The Wall Street Journal*. She conceived of Best Law Firms for Women, a benchmarking survey and competition she ran for a decade with *Working Mother*. In 2011, Debbie co-founded Bliss Lawyers and in 2020, her company was acquired by Axiom, the global leader in high-caliber, on-demand legal talent. In 2020, she also launched her new podcast, Inspiration Loves Company, where she explores how to do better and be better at life, work, and everything in between. Debbie and her husband live in New York; they have three sons.
